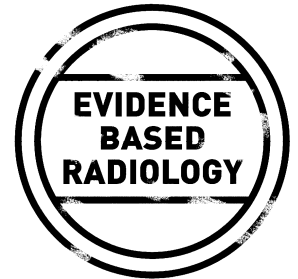


**EIBIR/EuroAIM Session
